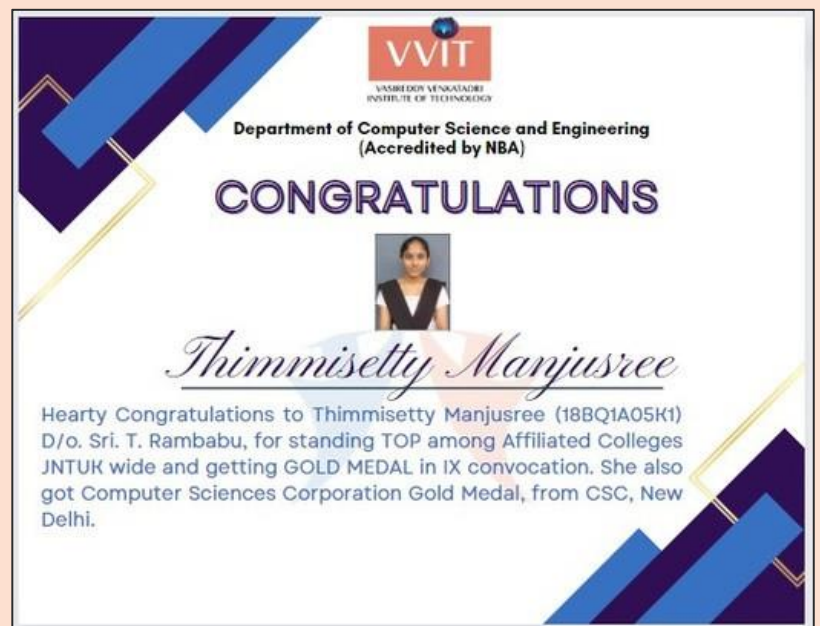
Dear Readers....!

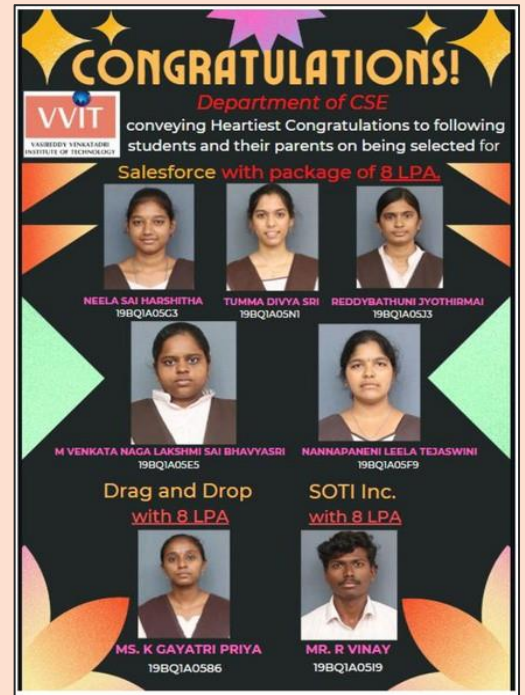

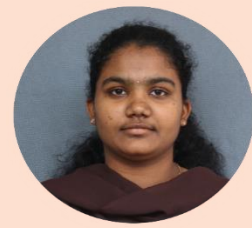
